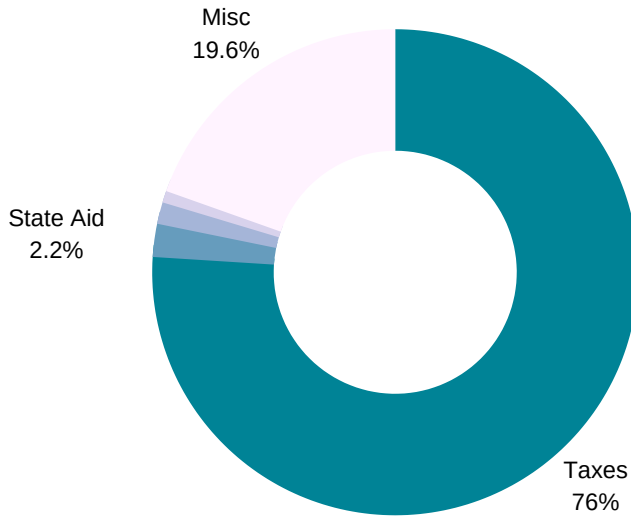

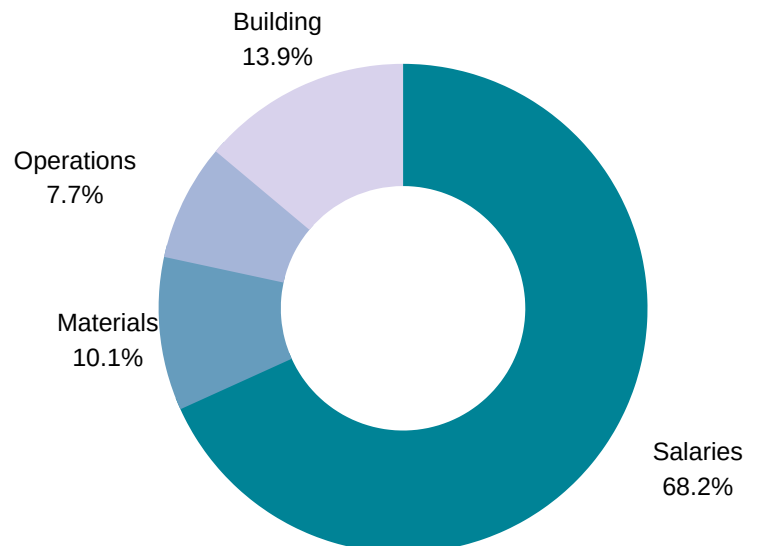

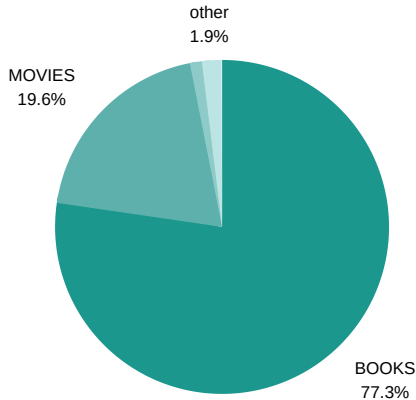

### TOTAL EXPENDITURES

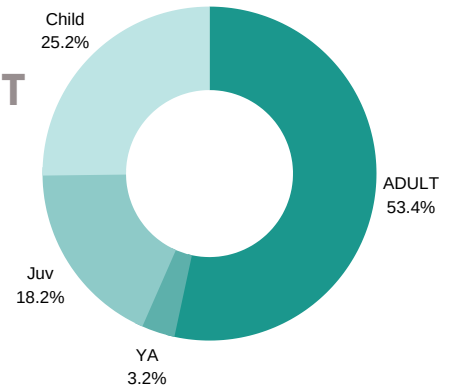

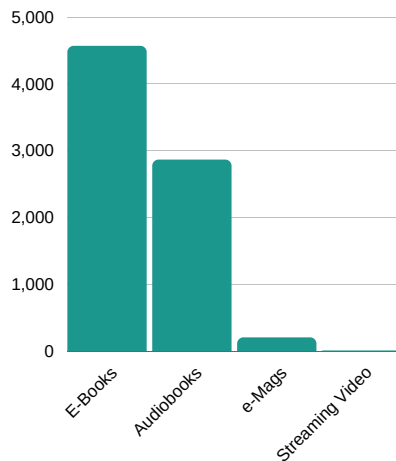

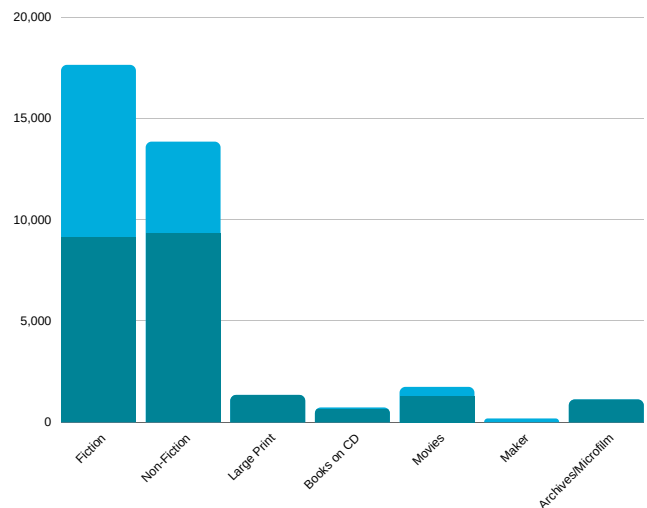
